

## Field Trip Preparation

## Reminders + Tips:

- Docent-guided tours last approximately one hour. Please note, early arrivals may not enter the
  galleries until the assigned time and late arrivals may have the length of their tour augmented. If
  you are running more than 10 minutes late for your field trip, please call our office at
  727.623.4778 to let us know.
- There are currently two (2) bus parking spaces in The Dalí Museum lot, which are free on a first come-first serve basis. Private Vehicles are subject to a \$10 parking fee in The Dalí Museum lot.
- For the safety of the collection, backpacks of any size (including backpack-style purses) are not permitted in The Museum. Complimentary lockers are available to store prohibited items.
- Phones are requested to be turned off or silent. Please turn the flash off for all photography in the galleries.
- Chaperones are required to accompany students at a ratio of one chaperone per 10 students at all times in all areas of the Museum.
- If you are planning to eat lunch before or after your tour, we suggest the Plaza area between the Mahaffey Theater and the Dalí Museum, or in Albert Whitted Park across from the Dalí. Please be conscious of the weather on the day of your trip. All outside food, drink, and coolers are prohibited.
- The Museum (including the café + shop) accepts only card payments at this time.
- Review our Experience Book to better assist guests with accessibility needs.

## Dalí Museum Educator Notice:

Please note there are collection items that contain mature themes. While these works are not included on the formal tour, we advise you to preview our collection online prior to your visit and note any concerns with your docent guide.
